URN visited Eco Pharm, Friecca, City Pharmacy and Zodiac Pharmacy in Kampala and confirmed that a bottle of 200ml of Chloroform goes for between Shillings 40,000 and 70,000.Although some of the pharmacies declined to sell Chloroform to our reporter, saying they didn't know her, one pharmacist said there is no proper procedure of selling it. "We sell it to people we know. Most of them are doctors and nurses working in hospitals but there are also those who are not. The good thing with those who are not using it in hospitals is that they are willing to pay a lot of money for it and so we get good profits. Imagine someone buying a bottle at Shilling 70, 000," the pharmacist told URN on condition of anonymity.Nation Drug Authority (NDA) allows licensed pharmacies to sell chloroform to medical facilities and hospitals. Fredrick Ssekanya, the NDA spokesperson, says Chloroform is only allowed to be in possession of medical facilities that carry out surgeries."Chloroform is a restricted drug and it should be accessed in authorized places and dispensed by qualified medical personnel as well as properly disposed of to ensure it doesn't end up in wrong hands," Ssekanya said.Adding that, "This drug is very dangerous. If 100millilitres of it is used on a person, the person can die. I have even seen someone who died after being injected just 5millilitres."Cases of theft and Robbery by use of chloroform have been on the increase over the past few years with 17 cases recorded in Kampala Metropolitan Policing area in 2016 while 39 cases were reported in 2017.Luke Owovesigiyire, the Kampala Metropolitan police spokesperson, says they have been receiving several cases but investigating them is never easy given that the victim in most cases cannot identify their attackers.//Cue in: "We have registered...Cue out: ... the investigations."//There are also cases of rape and aggravated defilement where chloroform was used on the victims. Data were judged inadequate to implicate chloroform exposure via drinking-water as a cause of human cancer. Concerning effects on the environment, the report concludes that the low levels of chloroform in surface water should not pose a hazard to aquatic organisms.
